

ORDINANCE #062794-A

BRUSH DISPOSAL

The purpose of this ordinance is to establish a uniform policy for the collection and processing of brush in the Town of Hull. The ordinance is necessary because of Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources requirements that all brush collected by municipalities be chipped.

Definition – **BRUSH** shall be defined as branches, tree limbs, small trees having dimensions no longer than 6 feet in length and no greater than 3 inches in diameter.

1. All brush to be picked up must be no longer than 6 feet in length and no greater than 3 inches in diameter.
2. Brush will be picked up at curbside on specific dates during the Spring and Fall. These dates will be made known to Hull residents via news media in advance of pickup dates. The Spring and Fall pickup dates will be the only Hull financed brush disposal during the year.
3. Brush piles to be picked up must contain **NO** barbed wire, steel rods, bricks or other foreign articles because of their potential damages to the wood chipping machine. If the town crew determines that brush piles contain non-brush items the piles will not be picked up.
4. Brush no longer may be deposited at the Hull Municipal building, 4550 Wojcik Memorial Drive. A clearly marked barricade prohibits dumping of brush.
5. Dumping of brush on public lands in the Town of Hull is prohibited.

This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as required by law.
