

Town of Hull Residents

Weekly Trash pickup and Every other Week Recycling

Residents will be provided with (1) 90 gallon trash cart (blue cart with BLACK lid) and (1) 90 gallon recycling cart (blue cart with GREEN lid). All residential trash must be bagged, tied, and fit in the cart provided. (Please note: if you currently have a Harter's or old "Wittenberg Disposal" cart you will not receive a different cart or additional cart. If cart rented in 2012, you will not be invoiced for the cart in 2013.)

Garbage and recycling needs to be curbside the night before but no later than 5:00 am on scheduled pickup day to guarantee pickup.

- Additional garbage carts and/or recycling carts are available for rent for a fee of \$75.00 per year.
- These carts are the property of Harter's, for cart repair or rental of additional carts; please call office at (715) 253-2619 or (888)804-8556. In the event you relocate, these carts are to stay with the property.
- Holiday collection will be delayed one day, if the Holiday is on a weekday, for the following Holidays: New Years Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas Day.

- Large Items (i.e. Furniture, Appliances (Non-Freon and Freon), and Electronics, etc) will be collected on the 3rd Tuesday of every month. Please call in advance to schedule pickup and for pricing information. The cut off will be 2:00 p.m. Monday the day prior to pickup day.

Yard waste and demo materials cannot be accepted. For yard waste and demo material removal, call our office for pricing on a roll off dumpster.

Recycling Information

The following items may be mixed together loose in cart

- **Plastics:** Bottles, Jugs and All plastics #1 thru #7, Food, Beverage, Deli, Yogurt, Cottage cheese, Bakery, Pill, Medicine and Kitty litter containers, Clear ridge clam shell packaging, 5 gallon pails, and Flower pots or trays.
 - All containers must be emptied and rinsed out, with caps removed.
 - Non-recyclable plastics: BROWN #1, Plastic straws, plates, silverware, drink pouches, Styrofoam (egg cartons, hot beverage cups, plates, packing peanuts/pieces)
- **Glass:** Jars and Bottles.
 - All containers must be emptied and rinsed out, with caps removed.
 - Non-recyclable glass: Window glass, Mirrors and Ceramics.
- **Cans:**
 - Steel (push partially attached lid into can)
 - Aluminum (do not crush).

Paper needs to be placed in paper bag inside the cart


- **Paper:** Newspaper, Magazines, Junk mail, Office paper, Paperback books, Telephone books, Catalogs, Cereal boxes, Envelopes (with or without windows), and Paper bags.
 - Flatten all: Paper egg cartons, Roll, Tubes and Container board.
 - Cardboard (Break down and flatten all boxes to a minimum of 2 foot by 2 foot pieces or smaller and bind them together).
 - Unacceptable paper includes: Paper Towels, Tissue paper, Waxed paper, and any other paper contaminated with food, grease or oil.

Used Motor Oil

- **Used Motor Oil:** Motor oil must be in clear (1) gallon containers with tight fitting screw on cap.
 - Maximum of (2) gallons per pickup.
 - Translucent Milk Jugs acceptable.


GARBAGE AND RECYCLING CART PLACEMENT

The front of the container which has the bar must face the road.



- ~ The collection system will require that the provided cart is mechanically picked up and then tipped into the truck. Residents are required to use provided carts for their household garbage and household recycling.
- ~ Each household is allowed one cart of trash per week. (Must be bagged/tied and the cart cover must close). Do not put any garbage in the cart that is not bagged and tied. Use only clear or white trash bags. NO black or Brown bags allowed.
- ~ Each household is allowed one cart of recycling every two weeks. **Do not place in plastic bags.** Loose paper can be placed in a paper bag on top of other recycling. (Cart cover must close). No need to separate recycling.
- ~ No garbage stored outside the cart will be collected. All trash and recycles must fit in cart provided with the lid closed. Do not place anything on top of the carts.
- ~ Place your cart(s) to maintain a (3) foot separation from obstructions, including other carts, mailboxes, parked cars, trees and snow banks. It is recommended that you place the trash and recycling carts on opposite sides of your driveway.
