

ORDINANCE #100291

ROADSIDE MOWING ORDINANCE

- 1) Main roads and through streets outside of subdivisions would be cut up to 7 feet off the paved and/or shoulder of roadway. Height of the cut would be approximately 2 inches.
- 2) Intersections would be cut up to 33 feet from the center of each road within the vision triangle both within and outside of subdivisions.
- 3) Except for intersections, no cutting would take place within subdivisions unless requested by property owners.
- 4) Unless increased or decreased growing because of weather conditions (i.e. abundance or lack of rain) cutting will take place twice per year:
May - June and August - September.
- 5) Height of cutting would be 2 inches on the main roads and at vision triangles (in and out of subdivisions). Height of cutting in subdivisions would be not less than 6 inches unless property owner preferred another height.
