


## *Water Projects going on in Town of Hull - Fall 2013*



Sept. - Nov. 2013 - Water Testing Program - Program for water testing available to all Hull households in October with presentation of results on November 14, in cooperation with Kevin Masarik, UWSP, Center for Watershed Science & Education. Presentation to be given at the Hull municipal building.

Fall 2013/Winter 2014 – Hull Southeast Sector Analysis - Analysis of historic well data from households and plan for on-going water data analysis of the Southeast Sector of Hull. Investigation led by Bob Enright, Sociology Professor at UWSP.

Summer / Fall 2013 – Stevens Point Monitoring Wells Analysis - Water depth data provided by Stevens Point of 6 monitoring wells in Hull's right-of-way. Data charted from 2003 to 2013, completed by Patty Amman, clerical assistant at Town of Hull.

Summer/Fall 2013, 2014, 2015 – Contamination in Hull - DNR/EPA grant to assess the sources of contaminants in Hull well water. Grant is for a 2-year period administered by UWSP College of Natural Resources Professor Paul McGinley & UWSP Lab Manager Bill DeVita.

Fall 2013 – Winter 2014 – Lower Well Water in Vicinity of Stevens Point Well #11  
An investigation of areas of Hull (Hwy. 66, Skyline Drive area) where water table has dipped causing the installation of new wells by households in the vicinity of Well #11. Collection and analysis of data and placement and platting on a map is planned. Analysis by water expert would be engaged by Hull such as a hydrologist.
