

9. Torun Road traffic recommendation plan for Highway 66 Project in 2025

- Letter was sent out to residents on Airport Road (about 9). There are three options with quickest option to direct traffic from Torun Rd to Airport Rd to get to and from WI-66 while construction is going on temporarily. Will take only 2-4 weeks to complete if they can shut down that part of Torun Rd completely; will take double that time if we have to narrow down to one lane at a time.
- 3200 vehicles per day on that part of Torun Road that we would be directing on Airport Rd. Airport Rd is average of 125 a day.
- We have heard from 3 of the residents on Airport Rd that do not want traffic directed to Airport Rd.
- We need to make a decision tonight on what route our town is going to take so we can notify the DOT.
- Two residents that have little ones are concerned with the extra traffic that will be directed to Airport Rd.
- Town will look in to options for safety when time comes to help slow the extra traffic down where children are present.
- Airport Rd residents at meeting would like to extend the time of the construction to keep Torun Rd open with one lane instead of less construction time to close both lanes asking Board to split traffic.
- Go in Torun Rd off WI-66 and exit from Airport Rd looks like the safest option if we go with the one-way route.
- FD/EMS would need to work out complications from a local rescue stand point.
- Motion to go with two lanes split on Torun Road
