 - FD- Ken Sadogierski Fire department, 27 members, 87 calls (123-2020) Rebuilt Fire Siren, New Tender, 60 Inspections, Smoke house for training for kids and FD Mark Fritsche EMS-10 members, 83 (96-2020) calls, Busiest months-Aug, Oct, Dec COVID challenged both Departments
 - Roads-Plowed 36 times, New purchase End Loader, Shady Oak project, Received a TRIS grant for North Reserve Dr
 - Building Inspections-Village of Plover providing service during transition due to accident of Building Inspector, several Backup plans also for future

- Building permits-Down for 2021
 - Clerk-Election stats, ACH updates, Absentee process explained-became very popular due to COVID
 - Salaries of Supervisors-per Diam suggested
 - Assessor's report-equalized value is 6% over last year, 46 permits, 5 for single family homes
 - Plover River Crossing-Wetlands owned by Town of Hull, waiting for Grant approval, Possible parking to be installed for area
