

MINUTES OF HULL TOWN BOARD MEETING,
COUNTY OF PORTAGE, WISCONSIN
HELD ON THURSDAY APRIL 25, 2019

01) Call to order by Chairperson John Holdridge at 10:00 a.m. at the Hull Municipal Building, 4550 Wojcik Memorial Dr., Stevens Point, WI 54482.

Present: Chair Holdridge, Supervisors David Pederson, Dave Wilz, Jan Way and John Koshnick.

Others present: Clerk Janet Wolle, Road Foreman Pete Kaminski, Deputy Clerk Barbara Brilowski.

Excused: Treasurer Jim Kruziki.

02) Vouchers presented for approval

Motion Supervisor Wilz, **to approve for payment vouchers presented**. Second by Supervisor Pederson. Motion carried by voice vote.

03) Request for culvert on Jordan Road by Pete Laskowski (potential property owner)

Barb Brilowski – Pete Laskowski stopped by to learn if a culvert can be placed under Jordan Road. He indicated water is on one side of the road but not the other. (He is proposing to build a house on the south side of Jordan Road across from 3006 Jordan Road)

Discussion:

- Not good drainage in this area of Jordan Road
- Berm for this area was designed by Engineer Dave Glodowski and installed
- Let water sit as long as does not go over road
- Putting culvert in would take water from one side of the road to the other
- Need background of the site
- Need engineering study (paid for by property owner?) before culvert installation is even considered

Motion Supervisor Pederson, **table action**. Second by Supervisor Way. Motion carried by voice vote.

04) Building Inspector responsibility and Hull ordinance relative to manufactured homes – Barb Brilowski

Barb Brilowski – four new mobile homes will be moving in to Recreates very soon

- Necessary to do a number of inspections once the homes are installed and before occupancy
- The Village of Plover Building Inspector department would do these inspections and all other inspections for Hull
- Have talked with Hull's Building Inspector Phil Deffenbaugh who has agreed to do the inspections of mobile homes – Phil to have process and fees charged by

Village of Plover in writing to Barb by May 6 for discussion at the May 13 board meeting

- Examples of UCD inspections to be performed once a manufacture home is installed or erected would be electrical, plumbing, anchorage, footings below frost lines, stairs, decks and outside buildings, etc.

Chair Holdridge – Look at mobile home ordinance adopted in 1965.

Motion Supervisor Way, **Building Inspector to carry out UDC inspections in Hull.**
Second by Supervisor Pederson. Motion carried by voice vote.

05) Brush pile pick up (from Hull April 8 board agenda)

Discussion:

- ❖ Newsletter states maximum dimension of the brush pile cannot exceed 12'L x 12' w x 6'H
- ❖ 2019 due to winter weather have high volume of branches down
- ❖ Road crew will pick up **all branches at curbside** regardless of the pile(s) size
- ❖ Will tweak the next Newsletter relating to branch/brush pickup

Chair Holdridge

- First Road Committee meeting held on April 24
- Group is very active
- Next meeting May 14
- ATV's-UTV's discussed

Discussed re: ATV-UTV:

- Use is about safety
- Get information and collect data
- Tires on ATV's are not for riding paved surfaces (can get a different tire for riding paved surfaces)
- Covering ATV's-UTV's on homeowner insurance policies is strictly for riding on the homeowners property – it does not cover riding on public roads – owner of ATV/UTV would have to get insurance coverage like automobiles are required to have
- No enforcing authority re speed, etc.
- Should ATV's be allowed to ride on roads after dark
- ATV's do not have signals – people would not see arm signals at dusk
- Identify process for making decision on routes/no routes
- Talk with other municipalities that have ATV-UTV routes

Chair Holdridge

- Stevens Point – Hull meeting scheduled for April 24 has been rescheduled for May 15
- Comprehensive Plan group will meet on May 8
- John will not be available May 1-5
 - Seniority goes to Supervisor Pederson to handle town issues during this time

Supervisor Wilz – email received from Mike Pagel re: wild parsnip and providing training for public works personnel.

Pete Kaminski – talked with road crew, they would very much like that training. It is possible could have wild parsnip in treed areas by parks.
