Recycling Oil

The process for recycling oil is as follows:

- Put discarded oil in a translucent container such as a milk carton. The container must have a “screw on” cap (No larger than a one-gallon container).
- “Two” containers allowed per pick up day.
- Place the containers containing oil “on top” of the refuse/recycling cart. (If you have a concern the containers could be knocked off the cart, set them next to the cart on the ground but toward the front of the cart).
- You may recycle oil on garbage only day or on garbage/recycling day.

There are times when the refuse hauler is operating a replacement truck due to breakdowns or maintenance issues. All trucks do not have room to store oil.
