## ORDINANCE #100291

## ROADSIDE MOWING ORDINANCE

 Main roads and through streets outside of subdivisions would be cut up to 7 feet off the paved and/or shoulder of roadway. Height of the cut would be approximately 2 inches.

2) Intersections would be cut up to 33 feet from the center of each road within the vision triangle both within and outside of subdivisions.

3) Except for intersections, no cutting would take place within subdivisions unless requested by property owners.

4) Unless increased or decreased growing because of weather conditions (i.e. abundance or lack of rain) cutting will take place twice per year: May - June and August - September.

5) Height of cutting would be 2 inches on the main roads and at vision triangles (in and out of subdivisions). Height of cutting in subdivisions would be not less then 6 inches unless property owner preferred another height.
